INTERNATIONAL STUDENT VISA AND IMMIGRATION INFORMATION

PC TECH recommends that students apply early to allow extra time for international mail and preparation of visa documents. IMMIGRATION INFORMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

In accordance with regulations of the United States Department of Justice and its Immigration and Naturalization Service, international students must obtain an appropriate visa to enter the United States for study. For PC TECH's students this will be the F-1 or M-1 student visa. An I-20 certificate of eligibility form is needed to obtain the F-1 or M-1 student visa at a U.S. Consulate or Embassy abroad. The Office of International Students will determine the appropriate visa status for you. **Students already in the United States should contact the Office of International Students about transferring or changing status**

FINANCIAL DOCUMENTATION & AFFIDAVIT OF SUPPORT FORM

Prior to an I-20 being issued, students must provide verification of adequate financial resources to cover educational and living expenses for the amount of time they intend study. In order to receive Form I-20 enabling you to apply for an F-1 or M-1 visa, you must provide evidence that you have financial support to cover the duration of your program.

Proper documentation includes an official bank letter, bank statement, or an employer's letter stating the salary of the student or sponsor. If funds will be provided by any person other than the student, the sponsor must complete the Affidavit of Support form (on back). It must be notarized and submitted with appropriate supporting documentation as listed above.

An I-20 cannot be issued without supporting documentation. You can fax or mail copies and keep the originals to present to the U.S. Consul for your visa application.

Please complete the Affidavit of support form. Any person providing funds to you must sign, and have notarized the Affidavit of Support form. Return this form with all supporting documents to PC TECH
